

How to request a one-off withdrawal on the Aegon Platform





How to request a one-off withdrawal

This guide explains how you can request a one-off withdrawal from a product on the Aegon Platform.

It can take up to 13 working days to process your one-off withdrawal request, subject to no further information being required. This time includes us selling the fund(s) and making the payment to you.

You can only complete this request online if you have transactional access and you're the **only holder on the account**.

If there's more than one account holder, please complete the **Withdrawal instruction** in black ink and email it to aegoncofundsadministration@aegon.co.uk or post to:

If this is for Corporate/Trusts, please complete in black ink and **post only**.


If you have view only access to your account, you need to contact your financial adviser or intermediary.

If you have access to our online services, you may be able to sign in and complete your action securely.


How to request a one-off withdrawal

1. Sign in to your Aegon Dashboard account.
2. Select the product you want to make the withdrawal from.
3. Select the **More options** drop down menu.
4. Then select **One-off withdrawal**.



Starting your one-off withdrawal request

1. Along the top of the screen you can see what stage of the process you're at.
2. We also set out what you need to do in order to complete the process.
3. Select **Start withdrawal** to continue.



Setting the withdrawal amount

1. Enter the amount you want to withdraw. We'll confirm if there are enough funds already in cash to cover the withdrawal.
If there's not enough cash, we'll need to sell funds to meet your required withdrawal amount.
2. **Select the option** and then **select bank account** to tell us where you'd like us to make the payment to.
3. Select **Sell funds** to continue.



You can choose to **Sell all** of a fund or give a monetary amount.


The band at the top will show how much you still need to allocate.

The yellow banner will turn green once you have allocated 100% of the targeted amount.


You can select to **Sell all** or you can enter a monetary amount




Completing the process
